

Hippocratic Declaration of non-AI Use

I have not used and pledge never to use artificial intelligence (AI) to enhance the planning, formatting, shaping, reshaping, executing, and writing of any aspect of my creative work, solely authored and attributed to me, including stories, novels, screenplays, poems, songs, lyrics, essays, and opinions. Spell check and grammar verification are the only automated tools of writing I apply.

This prohibition against the use of AI applies to any others whom I might engage for editorial advice or input.

However, once finalized as registered, copyrighted, or published, I may use AI to create derivative expressions of my original work for different modes of presentation, such as cinematic, streaming, audio, or televised, and will openly acknowledge the degree and manner to which AI might be used to do so.

Among many tools, I acknowledge AI to be useful to investigate topics of interest to enhance my ability to tell stories.

The primary motivation for my stance on AI is based on my personal quest over decades to develop my creative vision expressed in my personal style of writing.

My motivation is simple. I don't need AI to assist, in any way, the expression of my vision, revealed in my work in its finalized form. I want to see what I can achieve on my own, solely by my imagination, fueled by the personal development of my craft, drawing upon experiences in the many lives I have lived in this life.
